Coursework title:

Explain what we learn about Priestley's concerns by examining the Inspector's interrogation of Mr Birling

- 1 Research and make notes on *capitalism* and *socialism*
- 2 Complete the quiz given to you by your teacher – you will need to use the internet/reference books to research answers
- 3 Draw the Inspector and label with stage directions and quotation from the play
- 4 Write a private conversation between Gerald and Sheila from the previous summer (when Gerald stopped seeing her so often)
- 5 Write PEE chain paragraphs, at the end of Act 3: What do the characters learn? What does the audience learn?
- 6 Create a 'conscience corridor' for Eric – your teacher will explain how to do this
- 7 It is now 1915: what is each of the characters in the play doing now? Explain the reasoning behind your ideas
- 8 Write a newspaper article on the death of Eva Smith
- 9 Create a dramatic timeline for the play, using symbols and icons to represent characters and their actions
- 10 Write about who you think the protagonist (main character) of the play is. Give evidence for your ideas
- 11 Write the introduction to your coursework
