

In this term, students will develop their writing skills. Classes will explore and examine writing styles, persuasive devices and persuasive texts. Some homework tasks have been designed to extend and develop work completed in class, while other tasks are essential preparation tasks which need to be completed in order to participate fully in the lesson.

Below is a list of the homework that students will complete throughout this scheme of work. It is worth noting that the class teacher will set homework to support their class and so, as a result of this, the order of homework may vary or there may be additional homework to that listed below. For specific information, it is recommended that you contact the teacher of your child directly.

Year 7 – Spring 1 – Argue, Persuade, Advise.

- Pupils to collect and collate various types of adverts to use next lesson.
- Find out the significance and importance of closed and open questions and why advertisers use them.
- Find famous quotes from speeches and explain why students like them at the start of the next lesson.
- Bring in leaflets (not menus.)
- Fact and opinion work sheet.
- Bring in tourism leaflets.
- Think of some names for rides and the park.
- Written work.
- Peer and self assessment.
- Complete writing task.
- Produce a poster for the 5 golden rules of writing to advise.
