

In this term, students will develop their speaking and listening skills as well as their analytical skills. Students will engage in a series of speaking and listening activities and will also analyse poetry, whilst gaining an understanding of how poetic devices are used and the effects they have. Some homework tasks have been designed to extend and develop work completed in class, while other tasks are essential preparation tasks which need to be completed in order to participate fully in the lesson.

Below is a list of the homework that students will complete throughout this scheme of work. It is worth noting that the class teacher will set homework to support their class and so, as a result of this, the order of homework may vary or there may be additional homework to that listed below. ### **Year 7 – Spring 2 – Speaking & Listening and Modern Poetry**
