

In this term, students will develop their writing skills, analytical skills and their media studies skills. Whilst working closely with the 'Harry Potter' films and books, students will analyse the texts and begin to develop their independent learning and the skills they need to acquire to explain successfully. Some homework tasks have been designed to extend and develop work completed in class, while other tasks are essential preparation tasks which need to be completed in order to participate fully in the lesson.

Below is a list of the homework that students will complete throughout this scheme of work. It is worth noting that the class teacher will set homework to support their class and so, as a result of this, the order of homework may vary or there may be additional homework to that listed below. For specific information, it is recommended that you contact the teacher of your child directly.

- Write two paragraphs explaining which of the media discussed is the most important today and why.
- Students to draw a framing technique of their own.
