

In this term, students will develop their reading skills. Classes will explore and examine writing styles, language and characters. Some homework tasks have been designed to extend and develop work completed in class, while other tasks are essential preparation tasks which need to be completed in order to participate fully in the lesson.

Below is a list of the homework that students will complete throughout this scheme of work. It is worth noting that the class teacher will set homework to support their class and so, as a result of this, the order of homework may vary or there may be additional homework to that listed below. For specific information, it is recommended that you contact the teacher of your child directly.

Year 8 - Summer 1 - Macbeth

- Write a summary of the differences between the three different types of play.
- Make own notes on key characters and facts about them. Complete poster.
- Pupils to write a summary of the plot of the play and comment on why people would enjoy the play.
- Write a summary about Lady Macbeth.
- Write a newspaper article on an aspect of the play.
- Write own verse on character or theme from Macbeth (using Shakespeare skills and iambic pentameter.)
- Diary extract of Macbeth or Lady Macbeth.
