

Students' Cycling and Motorcycling Policy **W.e.f. September 2008**

Students in Years 7-11

Students in Years 7-11 should apply to Mr Schofield the Support Inclusion and Guidance Officer for a Cycling Permit provided the following conditions are met:

1. Each student wishing to cycle to and from school should, ideally, hold a Cycling Proficiency Certificate;
2. An application form is received from their Parent/ Carer stating that they wish their son/daughter to cycle to school. That the cycle to be used is maintained in good working order and has good quality working lights at the front and rear. Nunthorpe advises that a cycle helmet, reflective strip, be worn by the student seeking a Cycling Permit.
3. The student must agree to NEVER cycle inside the school gates and must follow the cycle route adjacent to The Studio to gain access to and from the Cycle Storage area. *Students must not cycle through the main car park.*
4. The student agrees to store the cycle in the school secure cycle store (between the Sports Hall and Technology Buildings) with a good quality cycle lock in use.

The Cycling Permit will be reviewed and re-issued each September.

Cycling Permits will be revoked with immediate effect if any student persistently ignores conditions 3 and 4. In such cases Nunthorpe reserves the right to confiscate the student's cycle and hold it for collection by a Parent/Carer.

Students in Year 11 ONLY

Students in Year 11 ONLY should apply to Mr David Page; Assistant Headteacher for KS4, for a Motorcycle Permit provided the following conditions are met:

1. A letter from Parent/Carer is received (addressed to Mr Page) stating that they wish their son/daughter to motorcycle to school, and that a motorcycle helmet, reflective strip and good quality motorcycle are owned by the student seeking a Motorcycle Permit from Mr Page.
2. The motorcycle to be used is maintained in good working order and MUST include good quality working lights as required in the Highway Code;
3. The student must NEVER exceed the school's 5mph speed limit required of all drivers, and, of course, drive in a mature, responsible and safe manner at all times;
4. The student agrees to store the motorcycle in the designated secure motorcycle parking area of the school Car Park (between the Sports Hall and the Technology Buildings)

Should any of the above Conditions 1-4 not be met, Mr Page will remove the Motorcycle Permit with immediate effect.
