### Changes to lunch time arrangements

Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s)

As many of you are aware, due to the nature of our academy building, one of our greatest daily challenges is to ensure all of our children enjoy a satisfactory lunch time experience. As the number of students on our roll has grown over time, lunch times have become increasingly problematic.

In an attempt to provide a much more pleasant and enjoyable lunch time experience for all of our young people, we are introducing 'split' lunch time arrangements with effect from Monday 2 July, which marks the start of our new academic year.

The start and end times of the academy day remain unchanged and we will continue to deliver five 1 hour lessons per day, therefore the academy day will be structured as follows:
