End of Term Arrangements

Dear Parent/Carer

As we approach the end of the summer term, I would like to inform you that we will have an early finish on the last day of term on **Friday 19 July at 1:00pm**. Students will have their tutorial period and lunch before a formal dismissal. We ask that students empty their lockers and take their lock home over the summer holiday.

The summer term is ending in very positive fashion with a very exciting Year 7 transition programme underway, fantastic sporting events taking place such as sports day and our inaugural Colour Run, as well as a successful Work Experience week for our Year 10 and of course the annual Prom for our Year 11s.

Of course, we hope the Prom is only the start of the celebrations for our Year 11 students and hope that in August, they are all celebrating the excellent results their hard work and dedication deserve.

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate the 302 KS3 students who were eligible for the attendance reward trip in early July and inform you that the academy's overall attendance finished on 94.5% this academic year. We have set a target of 95% for next year and will continue to reward those students achieving 100% attendance each half term.

Thank you for your ongoing support of our extremely high expectations with regard to uniform standards. These high standards are helping to support the productive learning environment our students' experience. However, there are some areas where some students are not quite getting it right and we feel it is necessary to clarify these with you prior to buying new uniform over the holiday period, and returning in September:

- Skirts must be knee length and can be pleated or straight with only one slit at the back- lycra / 'stretch' material is not permitted;
- Trousers must be grey, and must not be too tight or made from lycra / 'stretch' material;
- Plain black school shoes are required at all times. Training shoes or boots are not permitted;
- Make-up is not permitted for KS3 students (Yrs. 7-9) and only discreet foundation for KS4 (Yr. 10 & Yr.11) is allowed;
- Fake tan, false nails or nail varnish and eyebrow / eyelash tinting are not permitted;
- Extreme haircuts are not permitted and therefore, cannot be shorter than a 'Blade 2', have any tramlines shaved in or be dyed any unnatural colours.
