Dear Parents/Carers and Year 12 students

Year '12 face to face' opportunities from Monday 29 June 2020

Following advice from the Department for Education, Local Authorities and exhaustive risk assessments we are unable to provide physical 'face to face' provision to our current Year 12 in addition to our current Year 10. This is due to the wide range of subjects offered and the sophistication of subject knowledge required for each specification there would be too many staff and students accessing the site to facilitate face to face meetings.

We are therefore offering a 'virtual face to face' (via Zoom offer) which will enable a more personalised opportunity for all Year 12 for each of their chosen subjects to complete a minimum one, 1 hour session per subject with their subject teacher. The focus of this session would be:

- The quality of the work completed so far
- Detailed feedback for improvement
- Reaffirming expectations for Year 13
- Setting the scene for the next unit/topic to be covered

In addition they will have a virtual 1 to 1 appointment with either the Head of Sixth Form, Hermione Jackson or Assistant Head of Sixth Form, Sean Chuhan, this will be a 60 minute appointment with the opportunity to:

- Discuss any relevant pastoral issues/difficulties or concerns
- Well-being
- Future steps, UCAS or Apprenticeship applications

Our intention is to begin 'face to face' opportunities within the academy with subject specialists from Monday 29 June 2020.
