Isolated Learning will run from 9.10am to 4.00pm daily. Any student receiving a BFL will need to stay until 4.00pm. Parents/carers will be contacted regarding this via telephone or text. If a student is booked into Isolated Learning they should attend Tutor time as normal and they will be collected by a member of the Pastoral Team. Students will remain in Isolated Learning until 4.00pm. Parents/carers will be contacted if this happens.
