Dear Parents/Carers

I hope you and your families are well.

We have had a thoroughly successful return to the academy this week with 97.6% attendance, which just demonstrates how eager students and their families were for them to return to education this week. It was lovely to see everyone returning to the academy (even if you cannot see the smiles due to face coverings). It has been a very warming and positive start to the year. If this fantastic attitude to learning maintains students will very quickly be able to be supported to complete any learning missed due to the academy closure due to Covid-19 and quickly build upon progress previously made. Thank you!

The year group bubbles are proving successful and students have followed guidance carefully within the building. Some things have needed to be tweaked on a daily basis by myself and the senior team to ensure that processes are as smooth as possible and this will continue to be monitored on a daily basis and communicated to students in tutor time.

Please can I ask you to continue to support arrival procedures as closely as possible to prevent groups from mixing and to prevent congestion which has a knock on to the primary school entrance also. It is essential that students are not dropped off or encouraged to attend early as they will not be able to access the academy until their allotted time and becomes an issue for their safety on a very busy road. It is also essential that face coverings are worn on the student's journey to the academy when they can no longer maintain 2 meters social distancing from other people. This is particularly important as they get closer to the academy and to their lining up point. Face coverings can be removed once they reach their tutor room using their allocated route.

Coronavirus (COVID-19) testing:

The Department of Health and Social Care, NHS Test and Trace, and Public Health England issued a [letter to school and college leaders today providing clarity on when students and staff should be tested for coronavirus \(COVID-19\)](#).
