CYCLING/SCOOTER PERMIT - Students in Years 7-13

Students in Years 7-13 should apply to Mrs Odette Price, the Inclusion Officer at Nunthorpe Academy, for a Cycling/Scooter permit provided the following conditions are met:

1. Each student wishing to cycle/scoot to and from the Academy should, ideally, hold a Cycling Proficiency Certificate.
2. In order to safeguard our students to access the Academy site and the secure cycle/scooter store, a cycle/scooter helmet will be required to be worn.
3. An application form is received from their Parent/Carer stating that they wish their child to cycle/scoot to the Academy.
4. That the cycle/scooter to be used is maintained in good working order and the cycle has appropriate lighting during darker months. Nunthorpe advises protective clothing with appropriate reflective strips to be worn.
5. The student must agree to NEVER cycle/scooter inside the Academy gates or on the footpaths around the Academy. They must dismount at the Academy entrance and walk their cycle/scooter along the cycle route adjacent to The Studio in order to gain access to the secure cycle store.
6. The student agrees to store the cycle/scooter within the Academy's secure cycle store with a good quality lock. Each student MUST ensure they lock their cycles/scooters securely.
7. Any POOR cycling/or use of a scooter i.e. Riding on the back wheel, weaving in and out of traffic, mounting the kerb in crowded areas or carrying an additional student on the bicycle/scooter will be dealt with by the academy and a sanction maybe imposed.
8. Nunthorpe Academy accepts NO responsibility for loss, damage or theft of bicycles/scooters left within the secure cycle store. Bicycles/scooters are left at their owner's risk.

The Cycling/Scooter Permit once issued, will provide permission (unless revoked) for the full period of the student's attendance at the academy.

Cycling/Scooter Permits will be revoked with immediate effect if any student persistently ignores Conditions 4, 5 and 6. In such cases Nunthorpe reserves the right to confiscate the student's cycle and hold it for collection by a Parent/Carer.

Any type of electric scooter are NOT allowed on site.

This policy will be kept under regular review in light of legal developments and best practice.
